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

#### THE EUROPE BRIDGE

The Europe Bridge is an inclined bow-string arch bridge that spans the Loire River between Orléans and Saint-Jean-de-la-Ruelle to the north, and Saint-Pryvé-Saint-Mesmin to the south. This structure, with its modern asymmetric design, was constructed between 1998 and 2000.

It forms a part of the 'Loire à Vélo' route and features, in each direction, a wide cycle path that is separate from motorised traffic.

## **CARPENTRY STREET**

From the 15<sup>th</sup> century, the street was simply known as the street of the carpenters. From this street, one can access the Carpentery Garden and the Saint-Donatien Church. A notable house from the 16<sup>th</sup> century, classified as a historic monument, is located at number 24.

At number 32, the house dates back to 1501. Its half-timbered facade features Saint Andrew's cross panels and a brick filling. The joint facades of numbers 20, 22, and 24 were, on the other hand, constructed in 1758.

## **BOLLÉE BELL FOUNDRY AND BELL MUSEUM**

The chimes that have emerged over time from the Bollée Bell Foundry resonate within the walls of over 60 cathedrals around the world, including those in Orléans, Tours, Chartres, Ottawa, and Yamoussoukro. Each bell, crafted with the utmost care and expertise, represents a harmony of history and auditory beauty that has stood the test of time.

Adjacent to the foundry, stands an awe-inspiring metallic windmill dating back to 1872. Constructed by the Bollée family, this windmill is not only a marvel of industrial ingenuity but also a legacy that has been rightfully honored. Recognizing its cultural and historical significance, it was declared a historical monument in 1991, serving now as both a testament to the Bollée family's inventive spirit and a cherished piece of heritage that has weathered the passing of centuries.





Nestled in the heart of the picturesque village of Combleux, right at the entrance of the canal and near the Loire, the Écluse guinguette offers a charming escape in an exceptional natural setting. Open for the summer season, this destination perfectly combines relaxation by the water and exploration of the rich biodiversity of the Loire region.

## FLUVIAL EXPERIENCES AND GASTRONOMY

How about renting an electric boat to explore the Orléans canal with « Balades et Découvertes en Bateau sur la Loire »? Or perhaps you'd prefer to closely observe the local fauna and flora during an overnight stay in a traditional Loire riverboat with « Escapades Ligériennes »? ## HOW TO GET AROUND?



Tao Orléans Métropole offers a variety of modes of transport to help you get around:

## CYCLING

- Orléans Métropole boasts 358 km of cycle facilities. You can find a map of the cycle routes at: orleans-metropole.fr.
- The Loire à Vélo cycle route crosses the territory from east to west over 20 km and connects with the Euro Vélo 3 and Scandibérique.
- Vélo'+ is a service providing bikes for self-service hire.

## **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

- With 42 bus lines and 2 tram lines, the TAO network ensures service across the entire Orléans metropolitan area. This is supplemented by a network of coaches for regional connections.
- Tickets can be purchased via the TAO app, on the SNCF Connect app, or at tram stops. If you are located far from a tram station, the Résa TAO app allows you to be taken to the nearest stop in less than 15 minutes.
